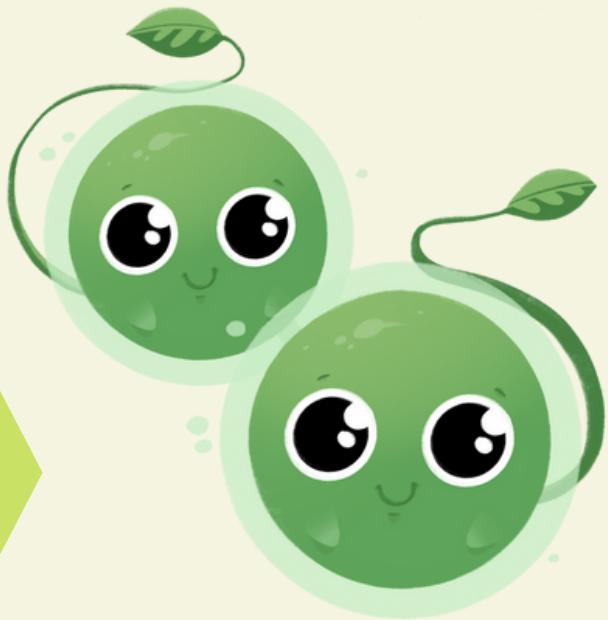




ROMAN NUMBERS
