RECYCLE WITH WITH VITA

These are the main garbage containers you'll see out in the street. Do you know what each one is for?



The yellow container is for plastic packaging and bottles, metal packaging, milk and juice cartons, etc. Careful! Plastic toys, baby bottles or plastic buckets don't go in this container.

The blue container is used for food packaging, shoes, frozen products, gift wrap, daily-use paper... Would a used napkin go in here? No, that's organic waste, as it could have oil or other substances on it that would mean it cannot be recycled.

The green container is for glass. It's important not to confuse crystal with glass, for example, a lightbulb or mirror aren't made of glass.

The brown container is for organic waste: food scraps such as fruit skins, fish bones, plants, eggshells, used napkins and kitchen roll.

The grey container is for waste that cannot be used to make compost, such as pacifiers, ceramics, pet litter...

Categorize this waste by coloring each one in using the right color, according to the container it should go in.

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
