FOLK TALE

Fictional stories by unknown authors. They originate from the oral tradition.

LITERARY STORY

Stories in which animals or objects acquire anthropomorphic characteristics (they look and/or act like human beings). There tends to be a moral or a lesson.

CHILDREN'S STORY

These are stories that aim to reflect life in agrarian or feudal societies. In this type of stories, maidens, princes, kings, and peasants are common.

FAIRYTALE

They're a key part of the learning process, as they stimulate the imagination through images and tend to give an exemplary message.

FEUDAL STORIES

The protagonists in fairytales are fantasy or supernatural characters, such as fairies, elves, witches...

FABLES

A fictional story created in writing, generally by a known author.
